

- \*Please note that the following products are not eligible for the subsidy:
- (1) Tours involving charter flights to/from Fukushima Airport (2) Staff involved in tourism-related businesses
- (3) Tours planned by Fukushima Prefecture

## **Documents required for application**

- (1) Form #1 [Application Form]
- (2) Sheet B [Tour Information]
- (3) Tour Itinerary
- (4) Documents verifying the recruitment details
- (5) Sheet A [Applicant Information Sheet]
- (6) Copies of the business cards of the representative and / or the person in charge of the application
- (7) A copy of the bankbook for the transfer account (or: Internet bank account information)

## Documents required for performance reporting


- (1) Form #3 [Performance Report and Invoice]
- (2) Sheet B [Tour Information]
- (3) Final Itinerary
- (4) Final Participant List
- (5) Copies of the accommodation certificates or receipts \*\*For more details, please refer to the subsidy guidelines\*\*

What counts as a 'tourist attraction' for the subsidy?

In addition to the places listed on the "Fukushima Travel" website, the tour can also include shops (and roadside stations) where visitors stopped to purchase souvenirs, experienced eating local cuisines, foot baths, fruit picking, and walking around town.


Can another company apply on behalf of the travel agency that designed the tour? If yes, what additional documents are required?
